The Council's procedure for public speaking at Planning Committee is contained in its "Guide to Speaking at Planning Committee Meetings" which can be accessed here: <u>http://www2.guildford.gov.uk/councilmeetings/documents/s16894/Guide%20to%20Spe</u> <u>aking%20at%20Planning%20Committee%20Meetings.pdf</u>

Page 4 in particular has a very helpful explanatory flowchart.

The process for this application coming to this Planning Committee has been as follows:

- 1. The application was received
- 2. 21 days were allowed for consultation
- 3. A decision was made that the application should be brought to Committee.
- 4. This Committee Agenda was published on 30<sup>th</sup> June

5. Public speaking is only allowed on applications at Planning Committee if, **at the date an Agenda is published**, more than 10 letters have been received in respect of a householder application or more than 20 letters have been received in respect of a minor/major application. As at 30<sup>th</sup> June the Council had received only 6 letters in respect of this application (therefore, fewer than 20 letters) which means there will be no public speaking on this item in accordance with adopted procedure.
