19/P/01003 and 20/P/01011 – (Pages 29 and 121) Land to the north of, Heath Drive, Send, GU23 7EP

Tree comments:

The Council's tree officer re-visited the site prior to 29 July and confirms opinion that the majority to be felled to facilitate development are multi-stemmed, poor quality Sycamore that have regenerated post the 1997 clear-felling.

The development will allow for woodland enhancements and improved 'legal' access for the public.

Nothing significant in regard to White Poplars.

There is significant opportunity for quality native tree planting to improve the biodiversity and structure of the remaining woodland.
