CO2 APPOINTMENT OF DEPUTY MAYOR

Although the Council, at its meeting on 8 February 2023, had approved the nomination of Councillor Nigel Manning as Deputy Mayor of the Borough for the

municipal year 2023-24, he had not been re-elected to the Council at the Borough Council elections on 4 May 2023.

Accordingly, the Council was invited to consider nominations for the appointment of the Deputy Mayor for the municipal year 2023-24.
