Support for Care Leavers, 10 September 2019, Minute OS17	A member of the Committee suggested that, pending a wider review of the housing allocations policy, the age at which care leavers' housing applications are reviewed and considered in the same way as any other housing applicants be increased to 25 years. In response, the Housing Strategy and Enabling Manager indicated she would raise the suggestion with the Housing Advice Manager.	<p>The Housing Advice Manager reports:</p> <p>I have now met with the Housing Lead Councillor Angela Goodwin and we have agreed that we can extend our current allocation policy to the age of 25 for care leavers SCC continue to provide an active support plan. We are currently agreeing a form of words to add to the allocation scheme that will be clear that a case must still be open to active support from Surrey County Council, i.e., a support package rather than the current situation which is the case is closed with no further support. We felt this was a good compromise and would mean the concerns over lack of on-going support could be addressed.</p>
