Members received and considered matters ongoing under the auspices of parish council Leisure & Facilities:

i) Ripley Village Hall. Members discussed the allocation of Section 106 receipts from the Garlick's Arch proposal. RVH trustees had met with Borough Council members and officers to confirm GBC's support following the election. The development of the land would provide funding for community infrastructure, without which the project to replace Ripley Village Hall would be unable to go ahead.
