Surrey Police, as a Responsible Authority under Section 13(4) (b) of the Licensing Act 2003, wish to make a formal objection against the application for a new premises licence for Oktoberfest (applicant Dream Oyster Ltd) on the grounds of Crime and Disorder and Public Safety.

Surrey Police have received an application for a new premises licence for the above premises looking at the application Surrey Police feel that there is not enough detail in sections M a) b) c) d) and e) detailing what the applicant is prepared to do to uphold the four licensing objectives, also more detail for section K which refers to Go Go dancing.

The premises is situated at the bottom of Bridge Street in an area of Guildford town centre known for venues which operate late night premises licenses it is adjacent to the Casino night club this area has traditionally had problems with crime and disorder, anti-social behaviour along with issues around patrons queuing and dispersal issues.

Surrey Police expect there to be more detail for a premises that will be operating late night licensing hours, more detail is required especially around the use of CCTV, the use of Security Industry Authority (SIA) accredited security staff coupled with a dispersal policy.

Surrey Police require an agreed worded licence conditions to be placed on the new licence and would be happy to discuss these conditions with the applicant.
