





Timeline and milestones

- December go live











Homepage design (with menu)















Landing / listing page

What goes in my bins?

Your wheeled bins (or sacks), caddies and other specified recycling items should be presented for collection at the edge of your property by 6.30am on the scheduled collection day.

Mixed recycling

We collect recycling in your green wheeled bin (or sacks if your property has been assessed as not being suitable for a wheeled bin for recycling) every fortnight.

This includes your clean and dry:

- Paper and card
- Glass bottles and jars
- Steel and aluminium cans.
- Fo
- Plastic bottles, tubs, pots, food trays and carrier bags
- Cartons for food and drink
- Plastic and metal caps and tops



This should be presented for collection at the edge of your property by 6.30am on the scheduled collection day.

If you have not yet received your wheeled bin or sacks please let us know using <u>Your Guildford</u>. You can request a larger or second wheeled bin for recycling by emailing the Customer Service Team at
