Notice under Regulation 10

In accordance with Access to Information Procedure Rule 15, I hereby give notice that the Chairmen of the Council's Overview and Scrutiny Committees (Councillors Philip Brooker and James Walsh) have been informed that the publication of the intention to make the key decision referred to in the table below under Regulation 9 of the 2012 Regulations is impracticable. This notice sets out the reason why compliance with Regulation 9 is impracticable.

Key Decision	Reason for Non-Compliance with the Notice Requirements of Regulation 9
Approval for entering into a gravedigging contract valued up to £250,000 over 5 years as per tender GBC 037862.	Start of procurement for this contract was prior to the Council's adoption of the new scheme of delegation to officers and financial and contract procedure rules. As the key decision to enter into the contract cannot now be taken by officers under the new scheme of delegation, it will need to be taken by the Executive at its meeting on 5 September 2024 to ensure that the new contract is able to commence on 1 October 2024.

The key decision referred to above will be taken by the Executive on Thursday 5 September 2024.
