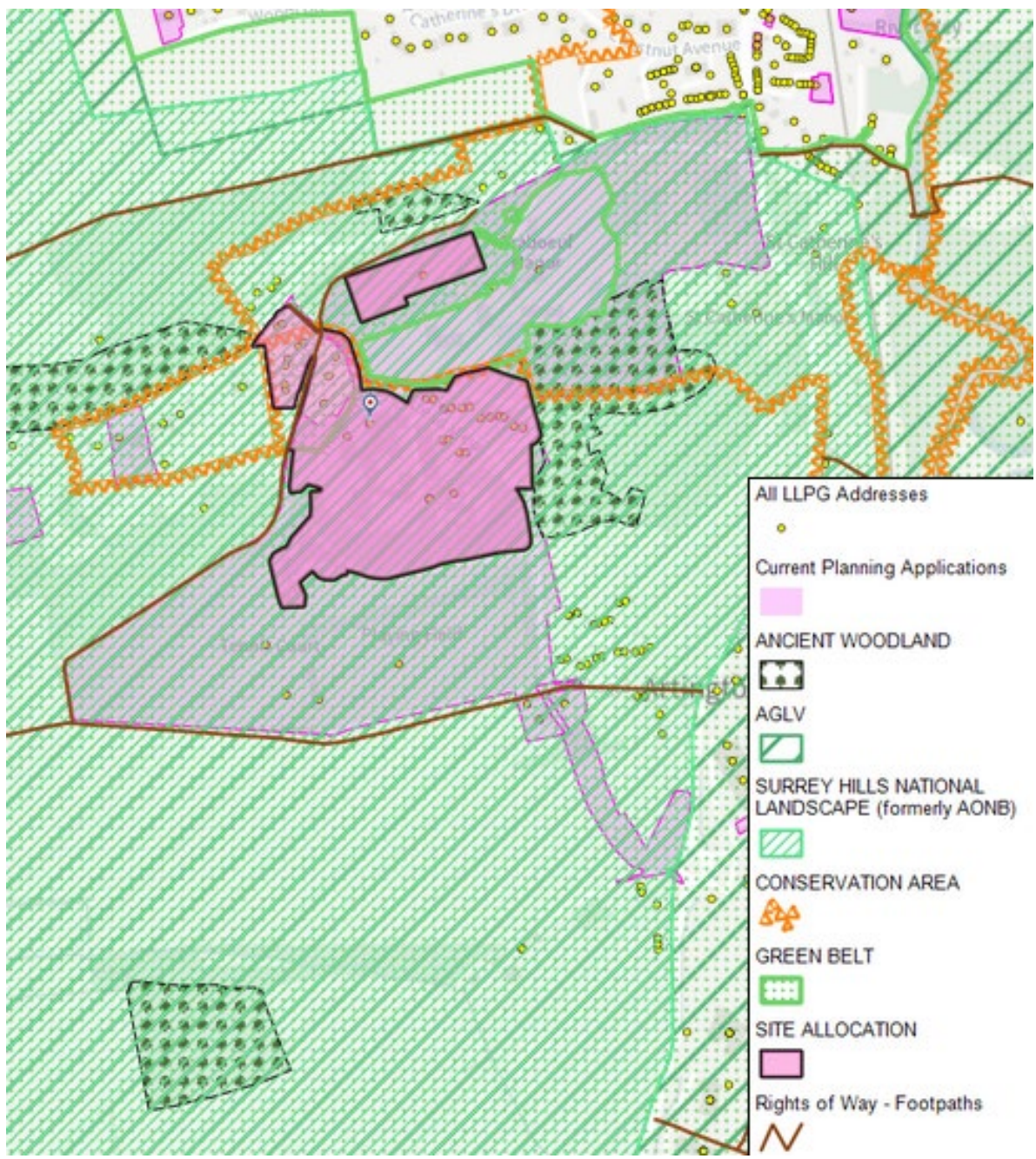


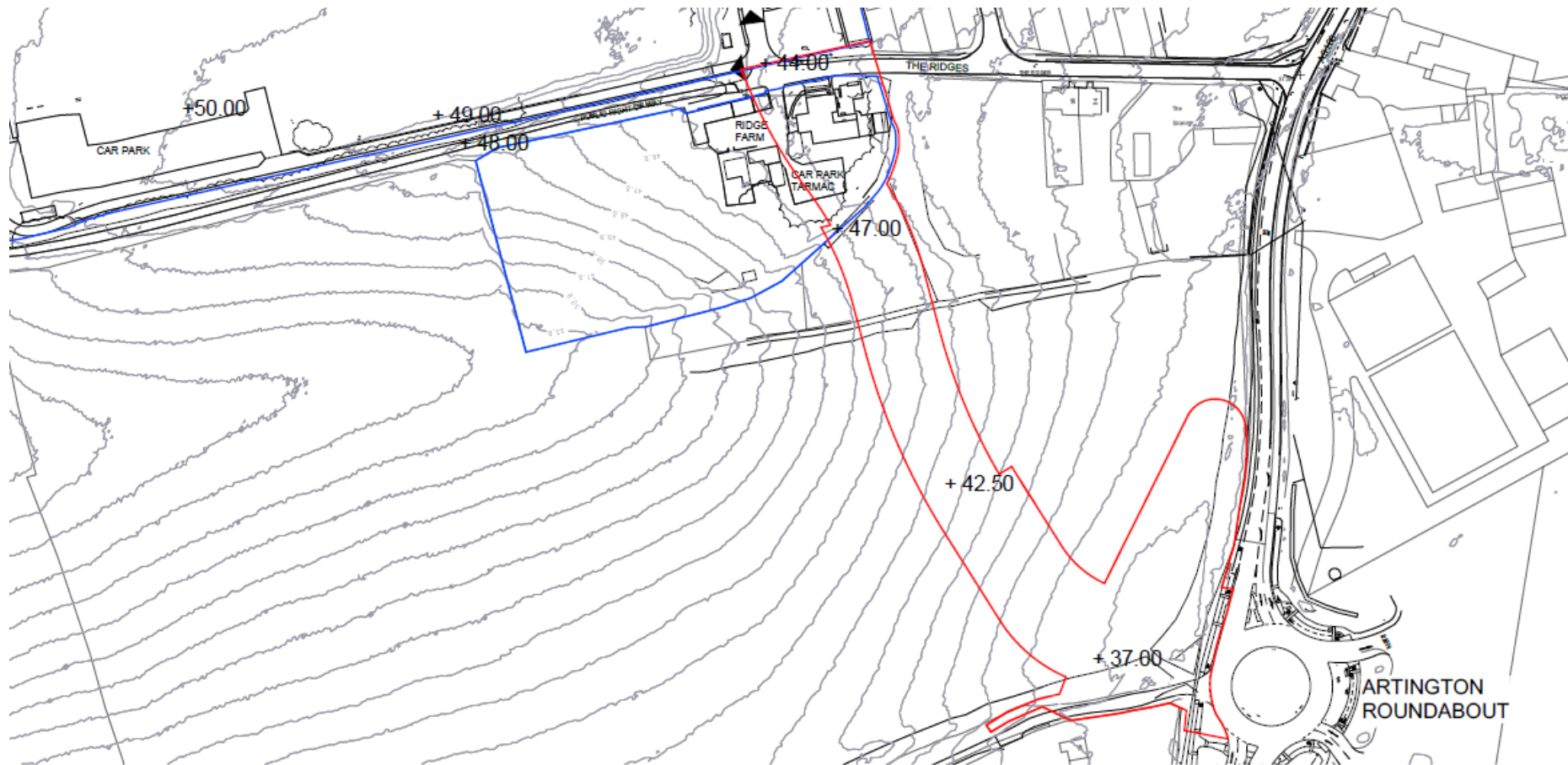
Proposed Site Plan (wider site)

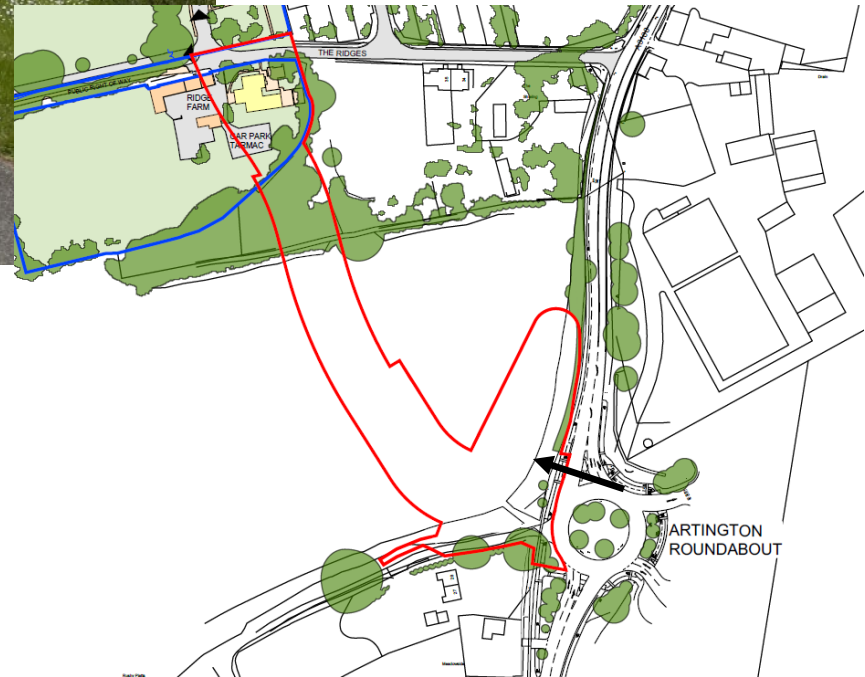

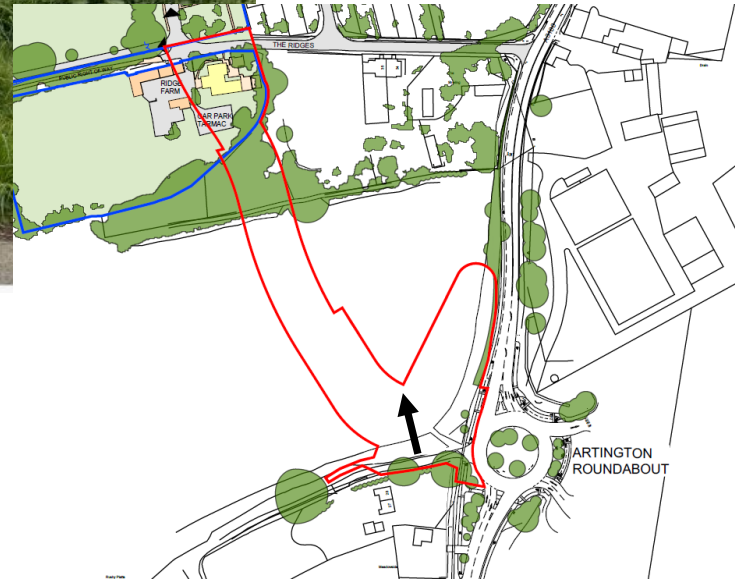

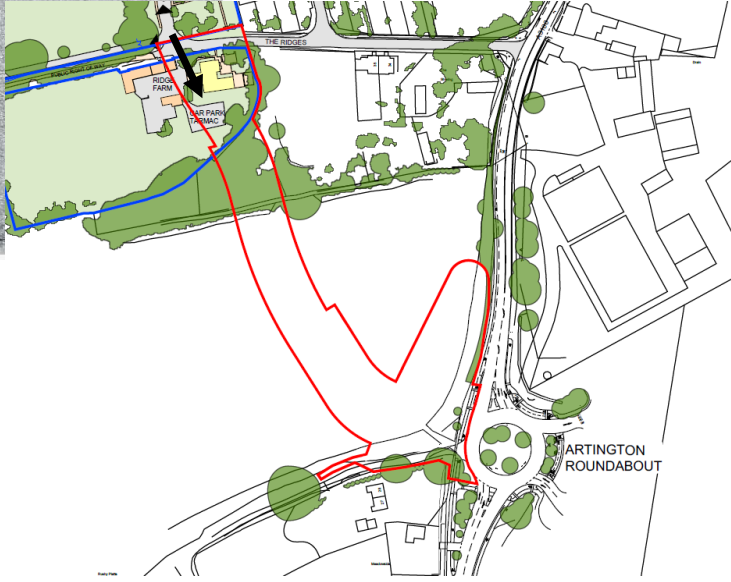

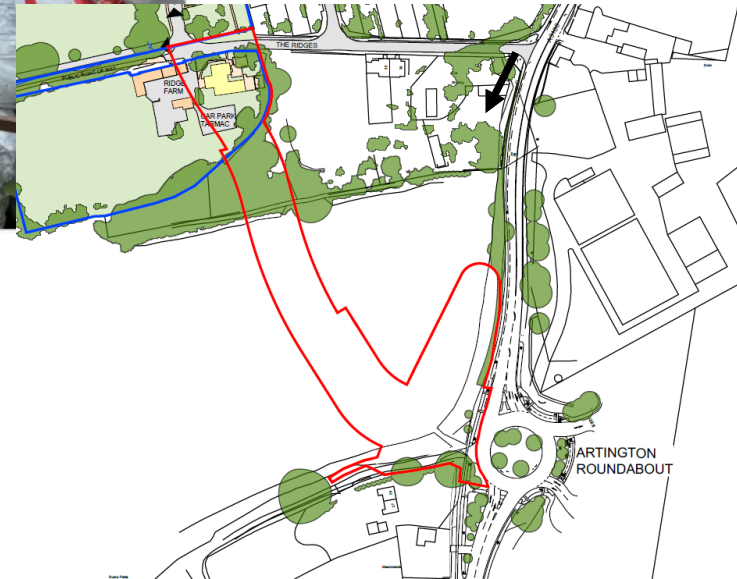
